## **Word from Pastor Solomon Olugbemiro**

CHRIST IN YOU, THE HOPE OF GLORY (Colossians 1:21-27)

With the challenges we are facing in our world today, how can a Christian navigate through life and remain true to their GOD? How can a believer live and experience God's glory in their life here on earth? What is the assurance that we can make it to heaven and experience God's glory as promised in the bible?

The real answer is that we cannot do it on our own. We cannot do it by our own strength. This is the message of the Bible. That is why it is called the "Good News". Without Jesus we are hopeless. Without the help of God, we cannot please HIM.

Apostle Paul unraveled this mystery in the book of Colossians 1:26-27 which says:

the mystery that has been kept hidden for ages and generations, but is now disclosed to the Lord's people. To them God has chosen to make known among the Gentiles the glorious riches of this mystery, which is Christ in you, the hope of glory.

This passage made it abundantly clear to us that the only way we can experience the glory of God, is for Christ Himself to live in us. It clear that we cannot attain holiness, we cannot achieve perfection on our own. The only hope for us is that Christ lives on the inside of us. Apostle Paul says Galatians 2:20

I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.



The whole essence of Christ being in you is so that his name can be glorified in your life not only in this world as HIS ambassador but also when you see HIM in glory









Our assignment is to raise godly children. They are our seed through whom we transfer God's deposits in us. We pass on the belief of our faith, the love of God and, the life of love to them.


you yourselves like living stones are being built up as a spiritual house, to be a holy priesthood, to offer spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ.
